This architectural attraction will present the rich history of craft in our region, focusing equally on past and present, traditional and contemporary. Its further mission will be to direct the visitor to the surrounding counties where work can be seen in artisan studios and venues.

`Round the Mountain has developed the jury criteria for Heartwood and will be holding the fourth Jury Session in the fall of 2010. RTM members will be notified when the session is scheduled.

### **Important information:**

- Only RTM members are eligible to apply.
- The first 50 members to submit their completed application will be juried in this first session. No faxed, emailed or electronic applications will be accepted.
- Do not submit work with application. The first 50 eligible applicants will deliver their work to the RTM office. Details will be provided upon jury confirmation.
- All work submitted to the jury process must be available for sale.
- If accepted by the jury, pieces with a wholesale price under \$200 may be purchased that day.
- At least one more jury sessions will follow over the course of the year.
- Applications received after the 50 member limit has been reached will be returned to applicant.
